

PUBLIC NOTICE - CITY OF DOUGLAS

PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING USE OF CDBG FUNDS

The City of Douglas is expected to receive approximately \$334,112 in FY 2010 Federal CDBG funds from the Arizona Department of Housing Regional Account (RA). CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need. Based on citizen input as well as local and state planning objectives, several projects have been selected to be forwarded to the State of Arizona with a request for funding. It is expected that the City Council will select final projects at their council meeting to be held April 14, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. and adopt applicable resolutions. The potential CDBG projects are named and described as follows:

- 1) Street Curbing and Drainage projects in Ward 6 and Ward 1.
