



NOTICE OF EARLY VOTING

CITY OF DOUGLAS SPECIAL ELECTION

MAY 17, 2011

Early voting may be easier than you think! If you are eligible to vote on Election Day, you are eligible to vote early beginning Thursday, April 21, 2011. It's fast, easy, and convenient. There are two ways to vote early in Douglas.

1. Early Voting in person-

Any registered voter may cast an early ballot in person at City Hall at 425 Tenth Street – just ask for the City Clerk's Office.

The City Clerk's Office is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The last day to vote in person is Friday, May 13, 2011. If you have a disability or have difficulty walking, call ahead to notify the clerk that you want to vote from your car. This procedure is called "curbside voting". The voting clerk will bring your ballot to your car outside the polling place. Curbside voting is available during early voting and on Election Day.

2. Early Voting by mail-

You may request a ballot by mail, by calling the Cochise County Recorder's Office in Bisbee at (520) 432-8354. You will need to provide them with your full name, address, and date of birth. The last day to request that a ballot be mailed to you is Friday, May 6, 2011.



If you are voting by mail, you are encouraged to return your ballot as soon as possible to allow the U.S. Postal Service prompt delivery of your voted ballot. Your marked ballot must be received by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day in order for your vote to be valid and counted.
