INTRODUCTION

In July of 2014, the City of Douglas became an Entitlement jurisdiction grantee for the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funds. As a grantee, the City of Douglas is required to prepare a Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) to analyze and summarize program accomplishments during the program year, based on goals and objectives set out in its Consolidated Strategic Plan and Annual Action Plan for the preceding year.

A public hearing on the report was held on September 14, 2016 at the City of Douglas Council Chambers.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) describes the City of Douglas' development accomplishments for Fiscal Year 2015-2016, with a special focus on those activities funded by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement funds.

Fiscal Year 2015-2016 focused on infrastructure, particularly, the demolition, and reconstruction of curbs, gutters, sidewalks and streets in low/mod neighborhoods primarily located in the Railroad Addition subdivision of Douglas.

These projects were determined through a Citizen Participation Process, in which the City held several public meetings and met with community stakeholders in order to determine the community's needs. Through this process, the City established the goals and objectives that are outlined in the Consolidated Strategic Plan Document, which consists of a Five Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2015-2019, as well as an Annual Plan for each consecutive year outlined in the Plan.
