**Traffic Control Measures - 3<sup>rd</sup> Street & Chino Road:**

Chino Road to Pan American Avenue is open to vehicular traffic. All vehicles traveling to Mexico via the Port of Entry are required to use this route. Heavy commercial trucks continue to be diverted to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street via 'H' Avenue. Construction continues on other roadside improvements along this route. We apologize for the inconvenience and we thank you for your patience.

**Border Fence Replacement Project:**

The Border Fence Replacement project, an Army Corps of Engineer project, is nearing completion. This project consists of replacing the border fence 3.1 miles east and west from the Port of Entry.

**Streets Maintenance:**

Streets Maintenance division will continue paving the Government Center parking lot. Crew will also be on 20<sup>th</sup> Street and Louis Avenue installing radius and drain boxes. This intersection will be closed.

**Special Projects:**

Water and sewer connection work continues at the Government Center. Fire hydrant relocation will take place at 20<sup>th</sup> Street and Louis Avenue. Re-adjustment of valve boxes and sewer manholes will take place along 20<sup>th</sup> Street from 'A' Avenue through Washington Avenue from February 22<sup>nd</sup> through February 24<sup>th</sup>.

**Fire hydrant and water system maintenance also continues along with miscellaneous concrete sidewalk repairs,** pothole patching, and graffiti cleanup throughout the city.
